**UU Housing Assistance Corporation
San Antonio, Texas**

UU Housing Assistance Corporation of San Antonio is a community housing development organization that helps low- and moderate-income individuals and families acquire or repair affordable housing. Since 1994, UU Housing Assistance Corporation has bought, repaired and sold homes to low-income family; repaired homes for low-income families in Beacon Hill; built and sold homes to low-income families. Currently UU Housing Assistance Corporation is buying, renovating and selling Beacon Hill and Alta Vista homes to low- and moderate-income families; repairing homes of low-income families in the Beacon Hill, Alta Vista, and Five Points neighborhoods; building and selling homes to more low-income families.



Since 1999, AEHS has provided UU Housing Assistance Corporation consulting services for asbestos and lead-based paint. Lead and asbestos inspections, lead risk assessments, and lead clearance sampling after renovation work has been completed under HUD 29 Part 35 are some of the services AEHS has made available to UU Housing. Additionally, AEHS meets with homeowners and contractors to review and explain the lead reports and scope of work before any work begins. These efforts give families and contractor a clear understanding of the lead process before any work begins.



Lead-Based Paint Training Courses

AEHS, Inc has been a training provider for lead-based paint since 1996 and last year trained approximately two hundred fifty (250) individuals in lead-based paint activities. AEHS provides Texas Department of Health credentialed initial and refresher courses for certification as Lead Inspectors, Lead Risk Assessors, Lead Supervisors, Lead Workers, and Lead Project Designers including Spanish-only courses for Lead Workers for both the refresher and initial course. The training facilities include classroom areas for instruction with the capability to hold up to 15 students per area, as well as, space specifically designed for hand-on activities. This includes a simulated abatement area where students can practice with abatement tools the techniques necessary to complete a job successfully. Students leave with real world skills and knowledge making them ready to perform on the job site.
